FRISCO HIGHLINE TRAIL

"A 35-Mile Adventure from City to Countryside"

Southwest Missouri's premier rail-trail stretches from Springfield to Bolivar. The Frisco Highline is a beloved regional backbone—supporting cyclists, runners, and hikers while connecting small towns and rural landscapes. Ongoing improvements and connections bring even more communities into the network.

\$24.8 2024 RAISE Grant Westside Connections

Closes critical gaps in the Jordan Creek, Wilson's Creek, and Trail of Tears Greenways, creating 3.14 miles of continuous trail. Eliminates barriers between west-side neighborhoods, regional parks, and downtown—linking communities, transit, and jobs while enhancing equity, access, and quality of life.

Wilson's Creek-South Creek (Posenke) Gap

Nearly 30 years in the making! This 0.46-mile connection will link Wilson's Creek and South Creek Greenways into 14+ miles of continuous trail across Springfield. Final engineering is underway, with construction planned for Spring 2026

Engineering is funding for Wilsons Creek west to ZZ in Republic.

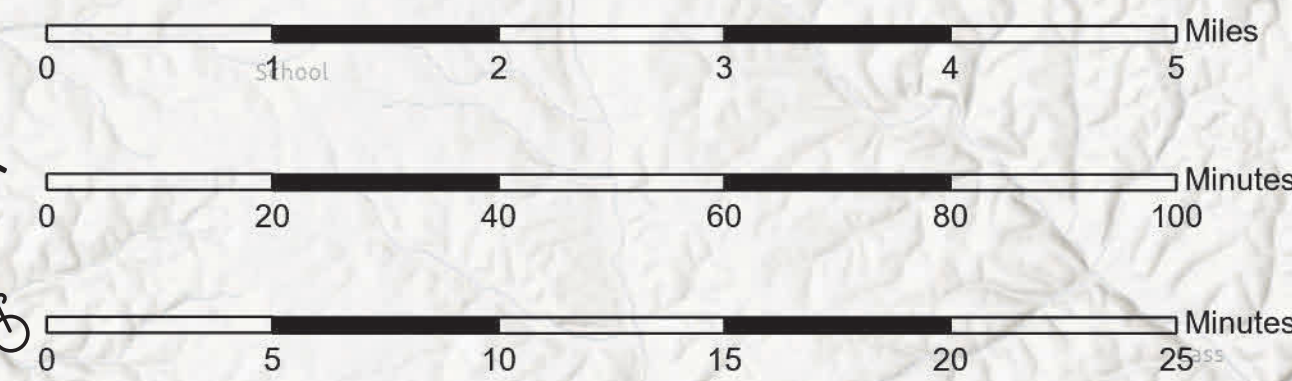
